



A note from the Superintendent,

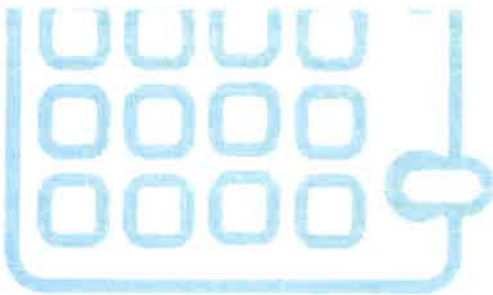
